Practice measuring the length of garden vegetables in inches with this activity.

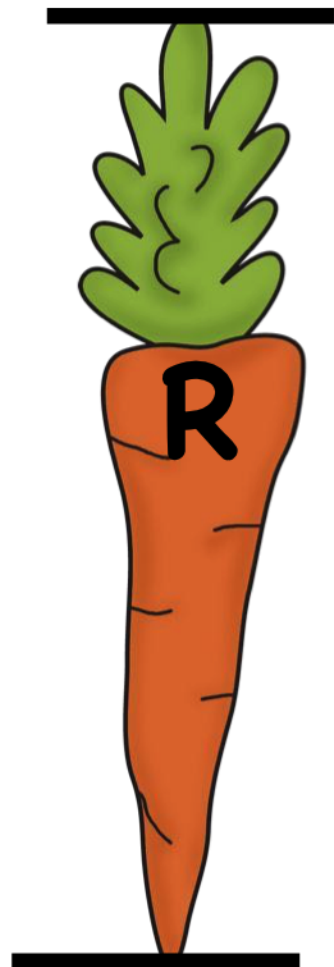
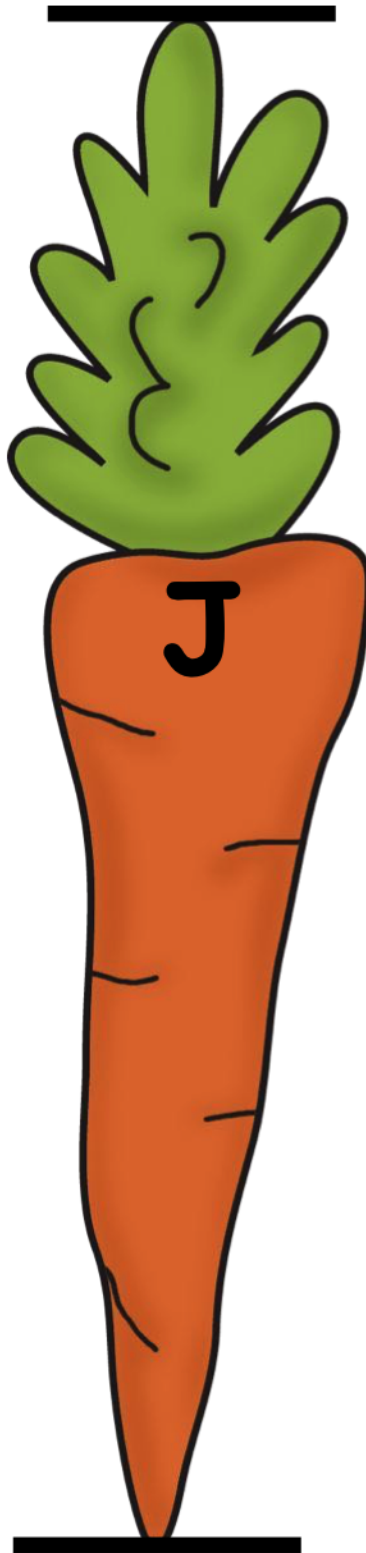
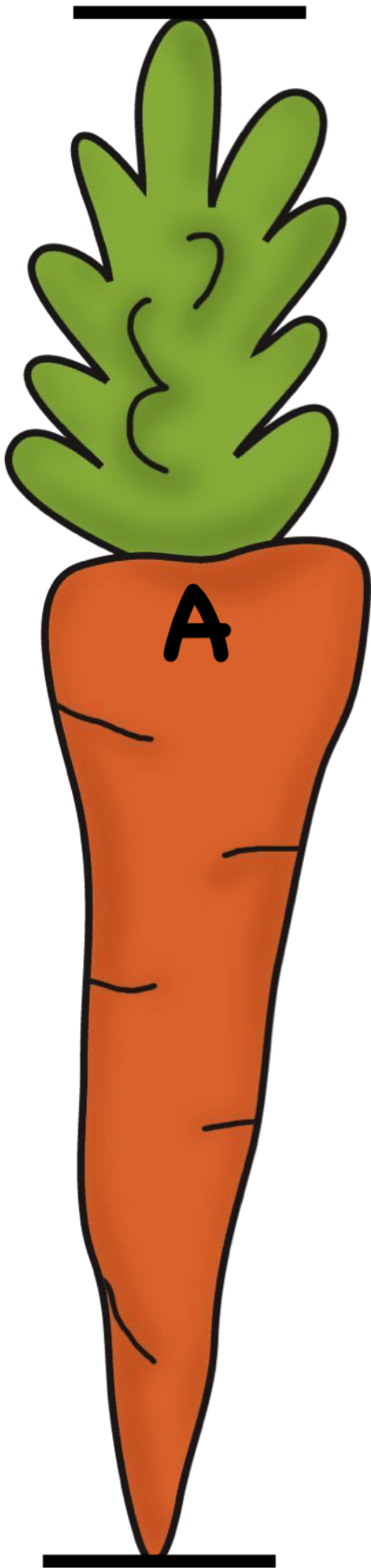
Version 1- Write the Room

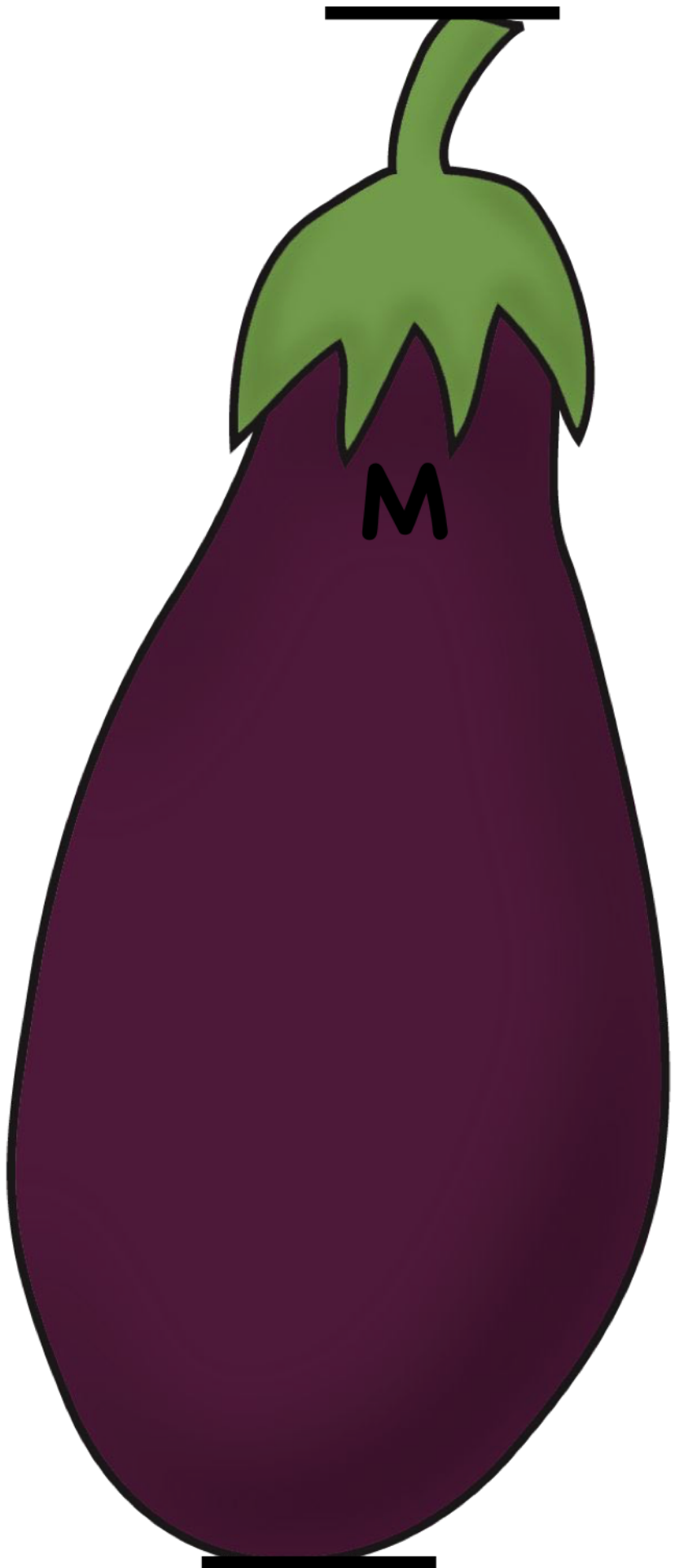
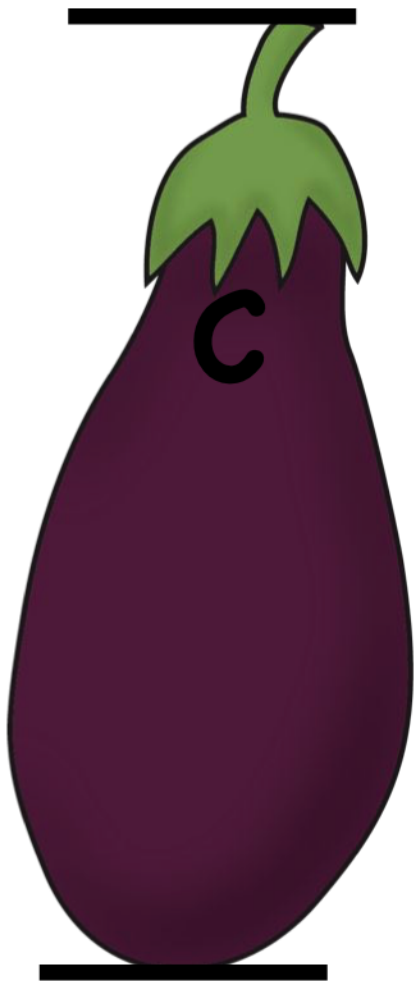
Version 2- Vegetable Picking

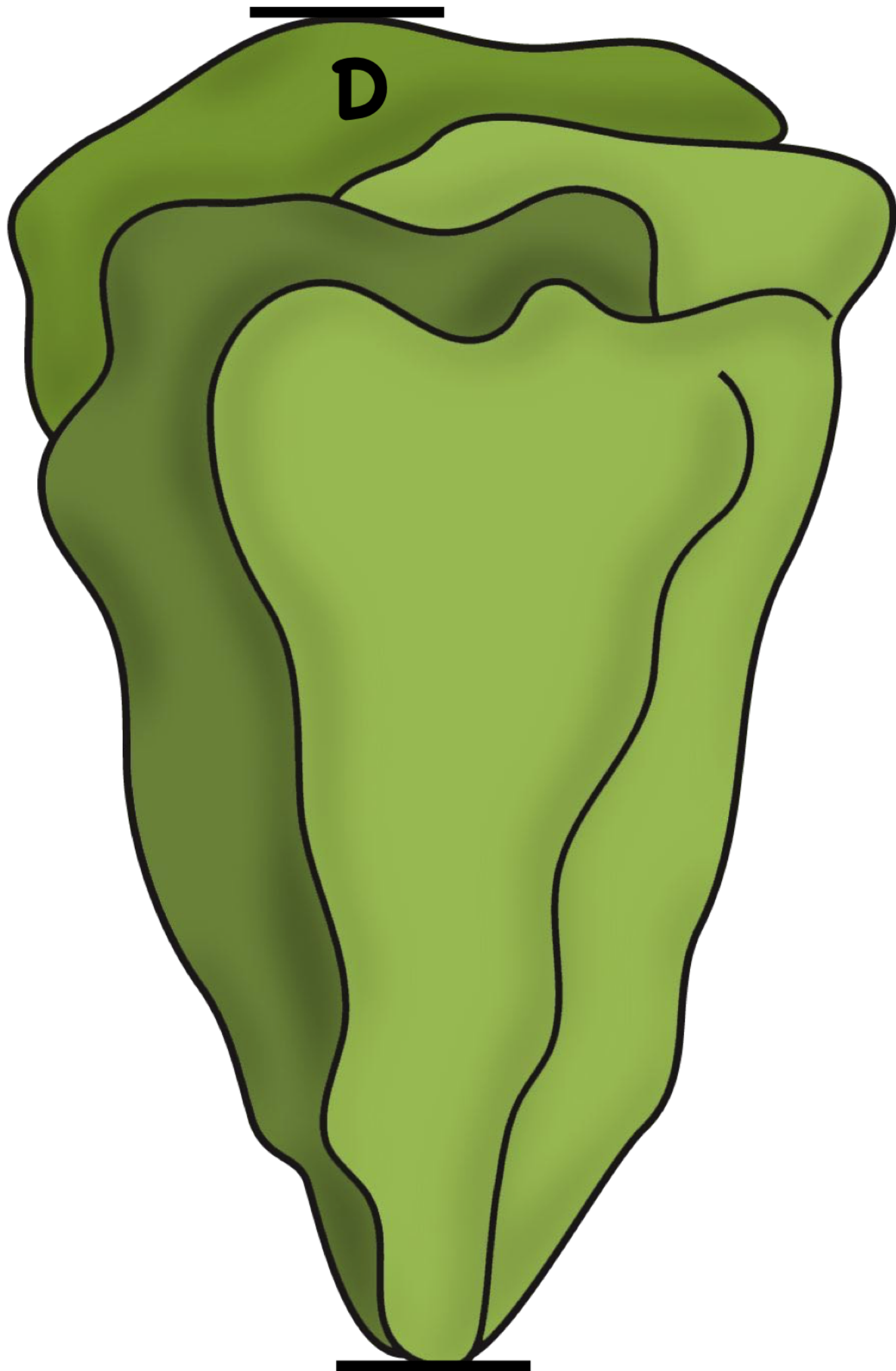
Place one of each vegetable on the garden mat. Use the vegetable worksheet to record each vegetable's length in inches.

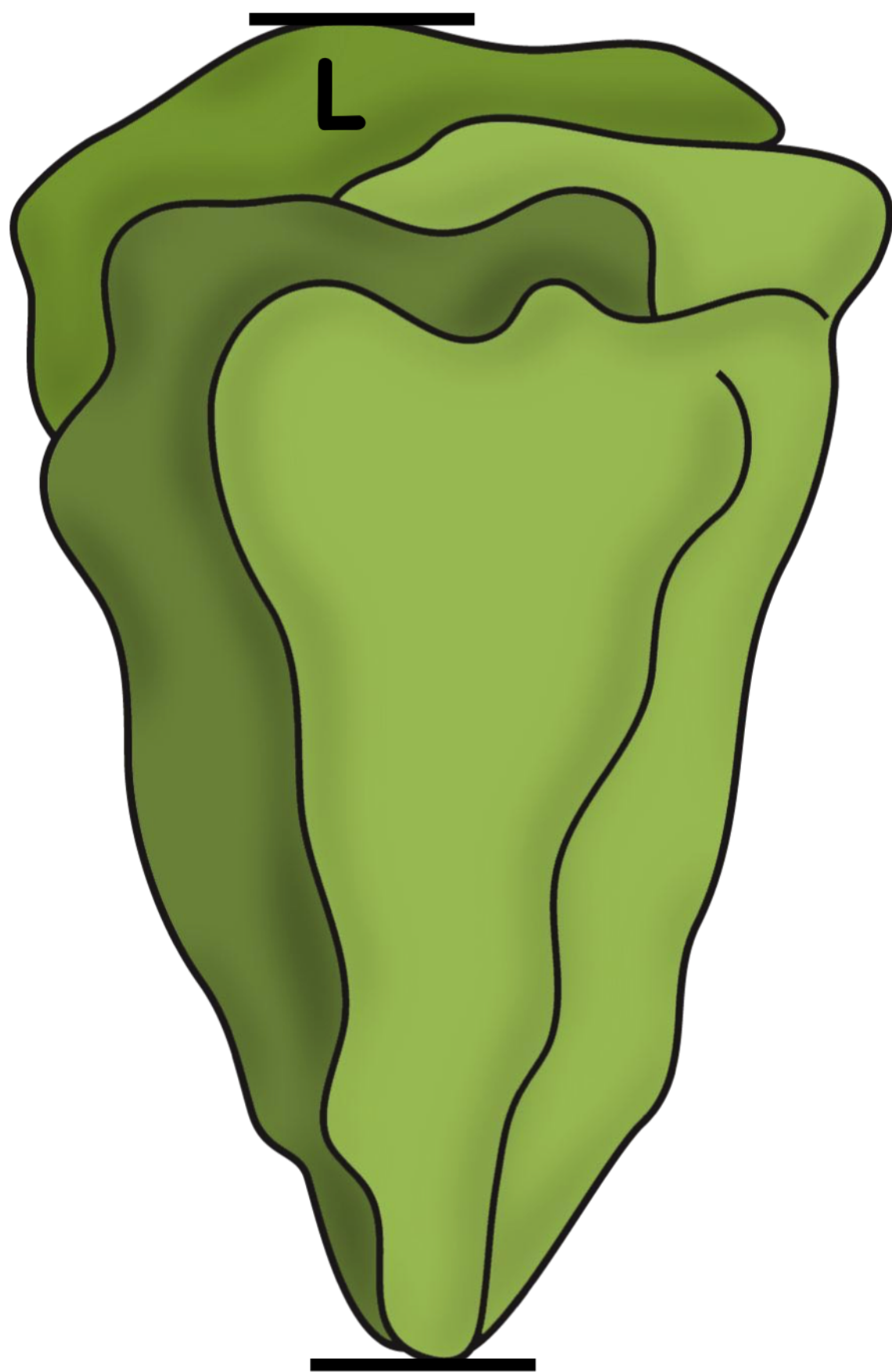
*For a fun twist, cut slits in the top of a cardboard box and place the vegetables half way inside. Students can 'pick' each vegetable from the garden!

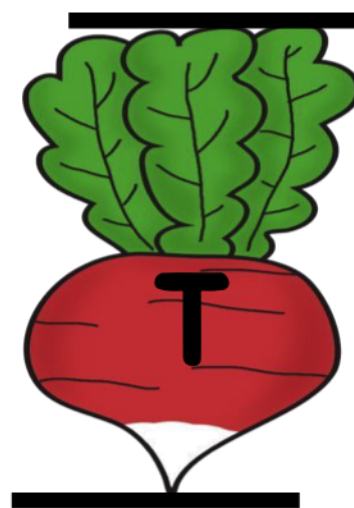
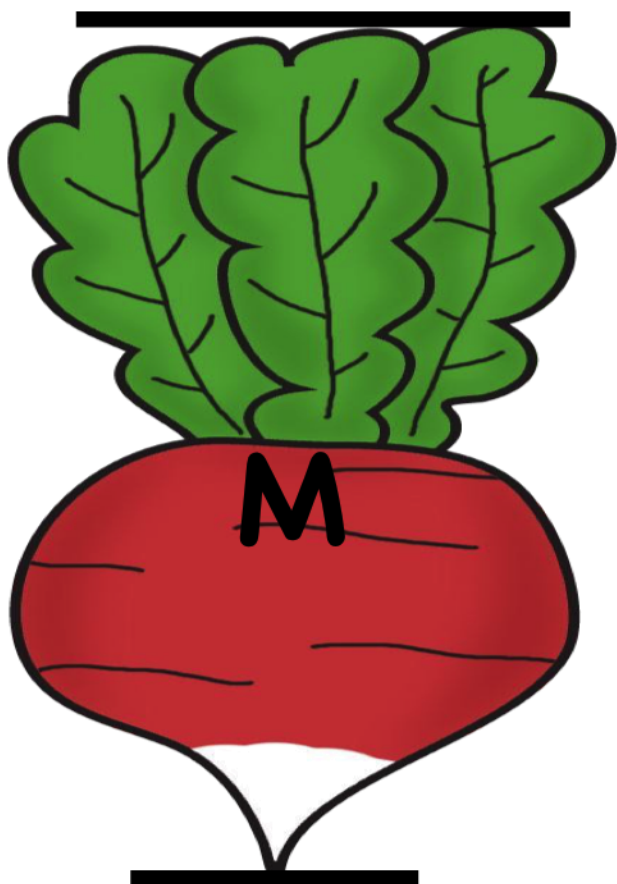
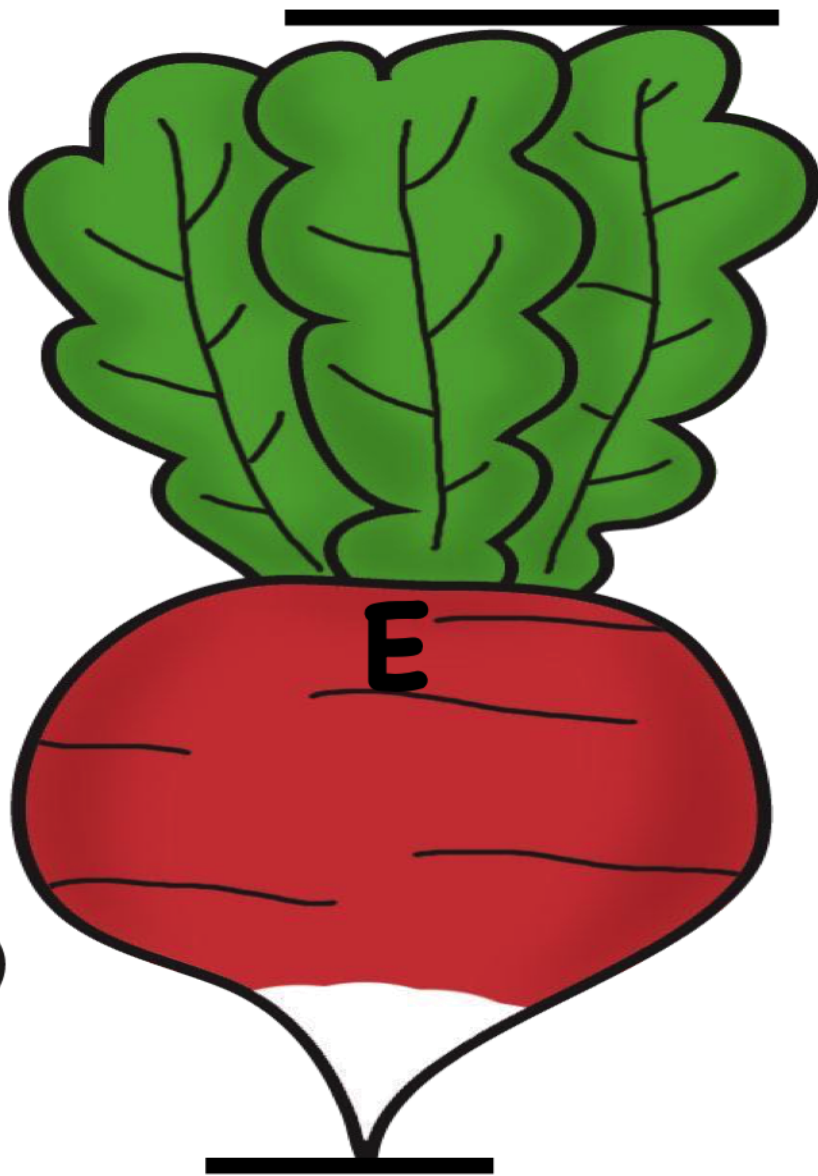


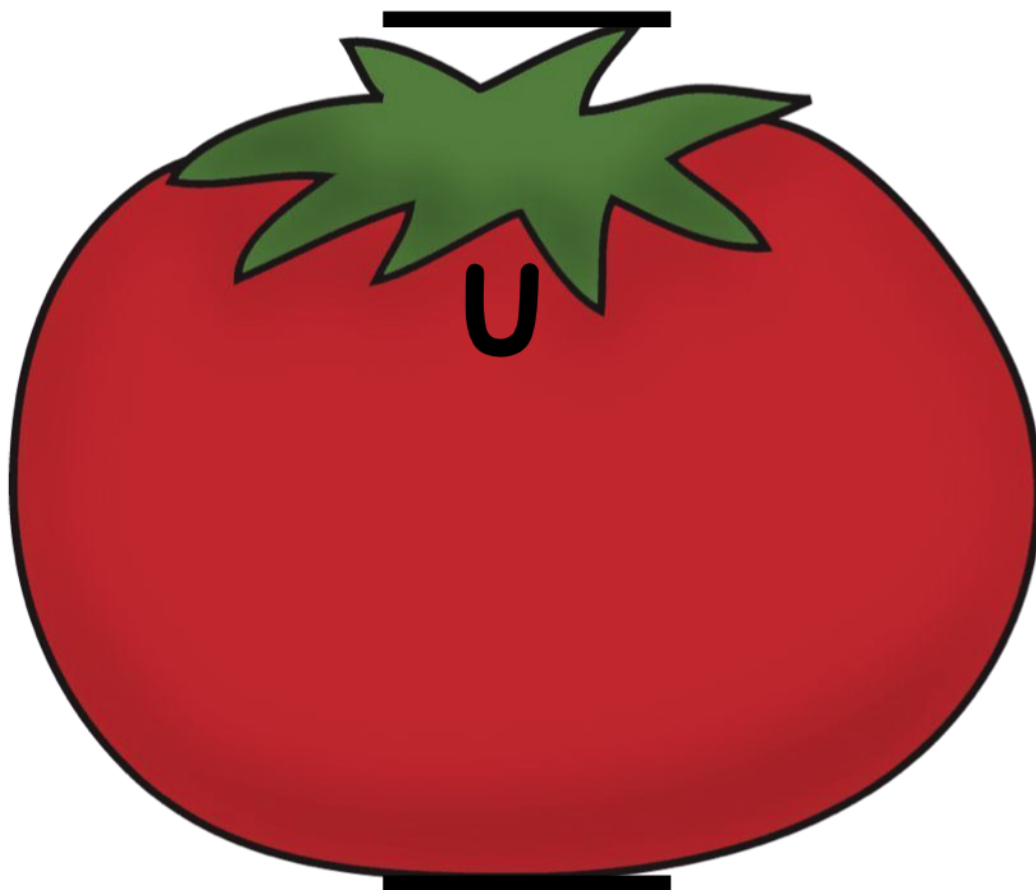
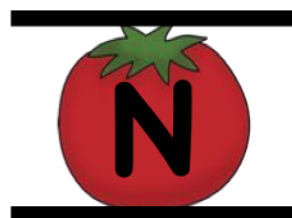
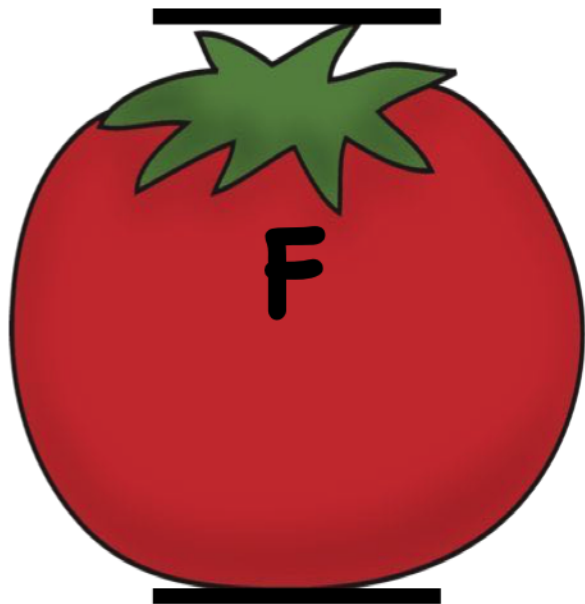


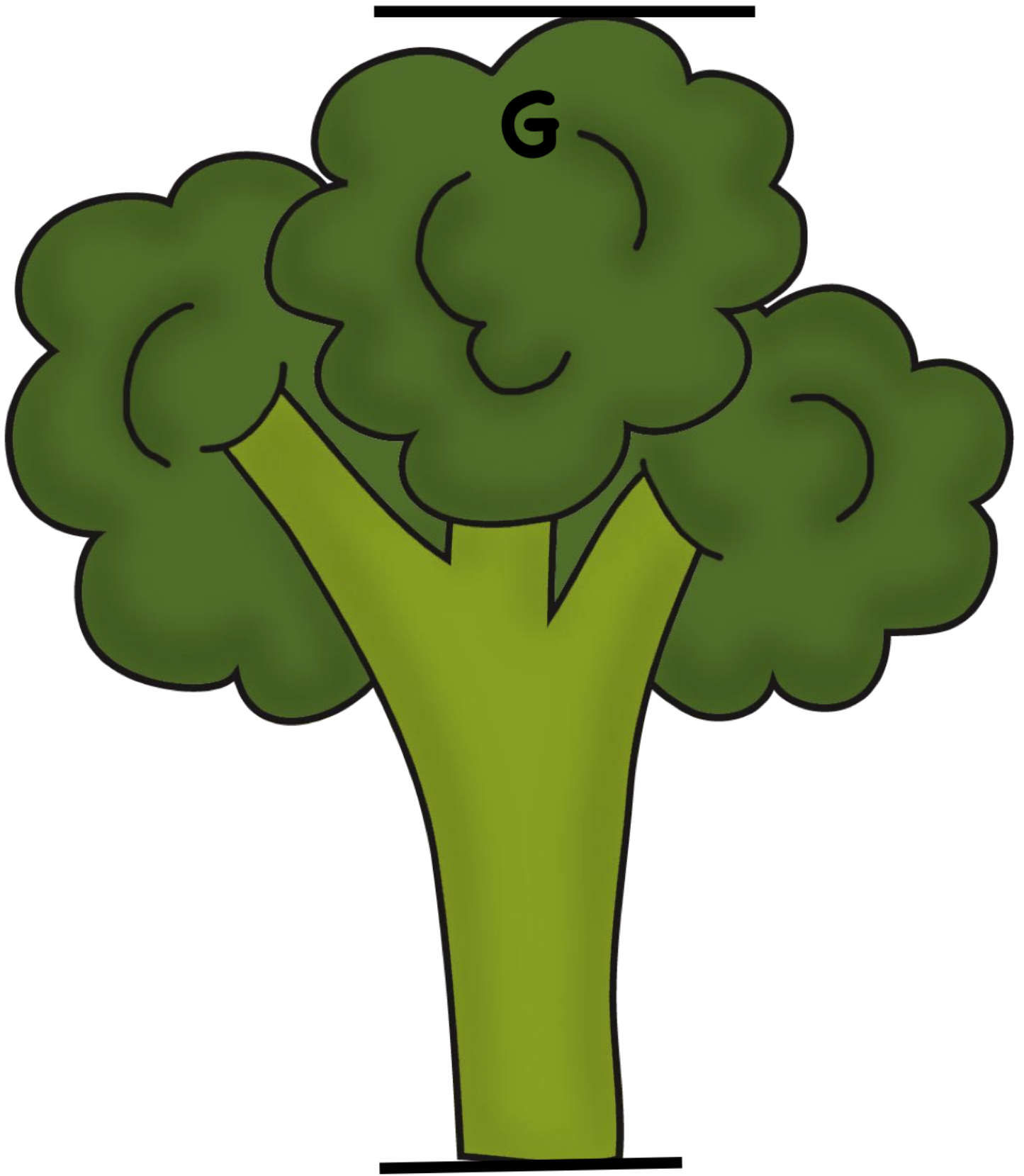


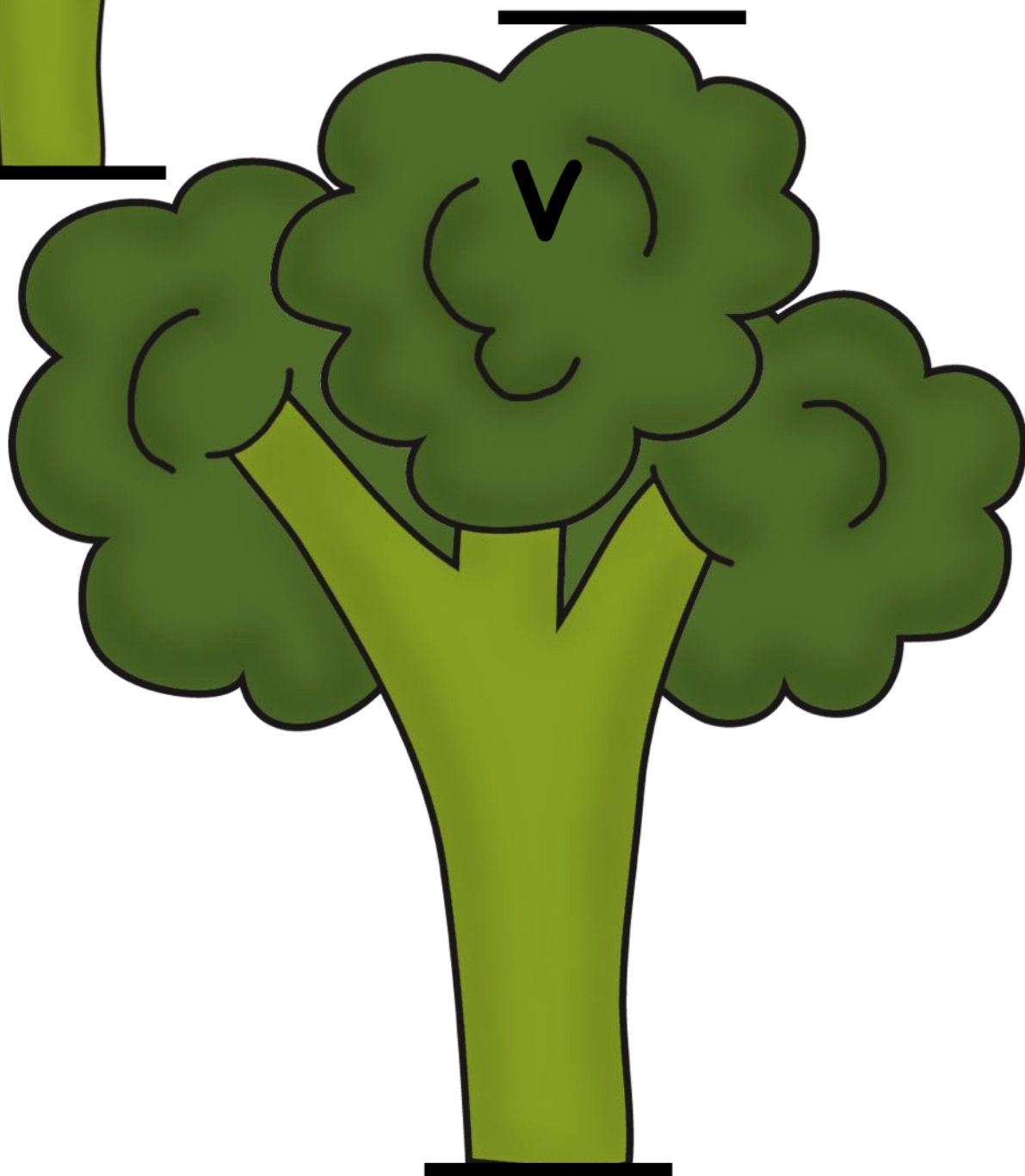


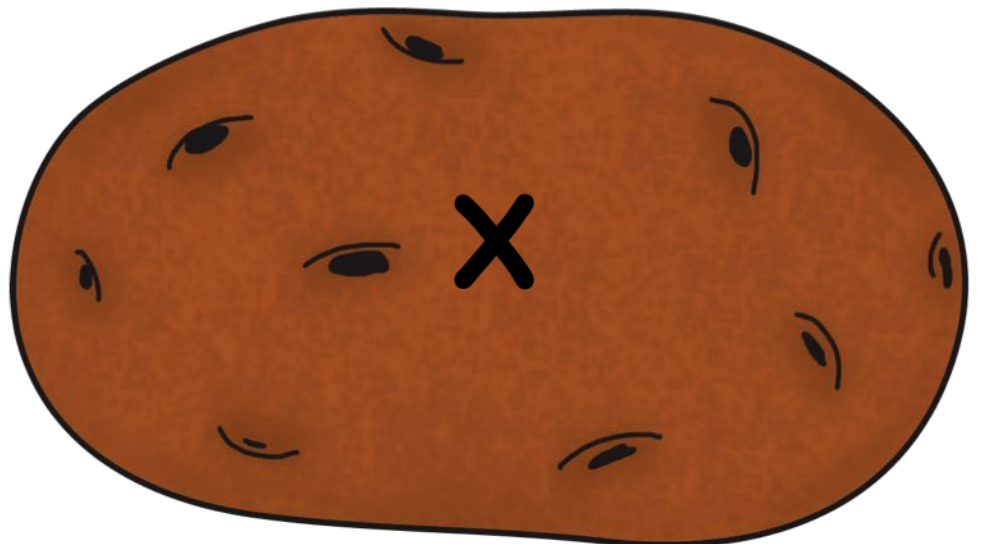
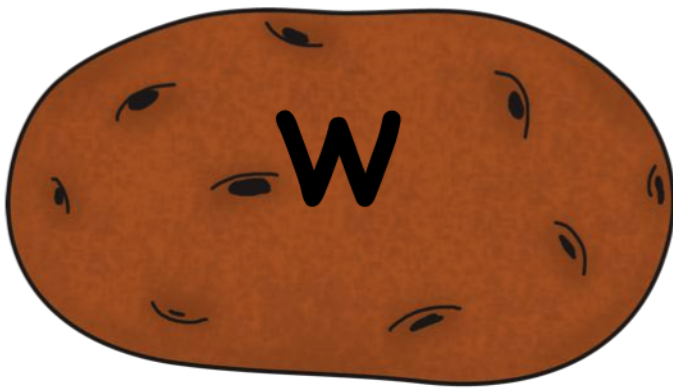
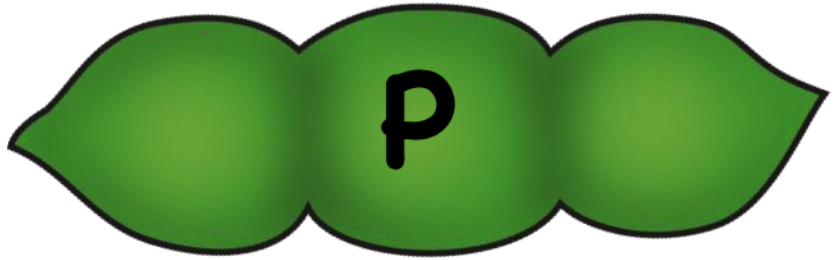


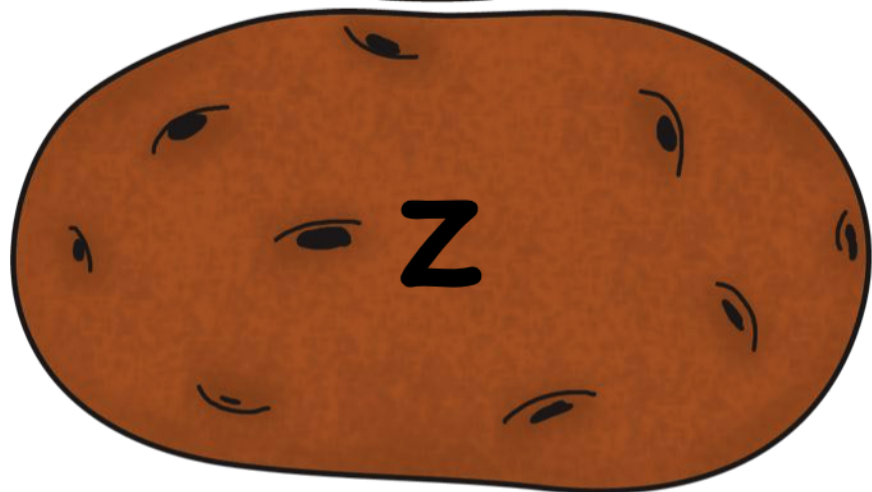
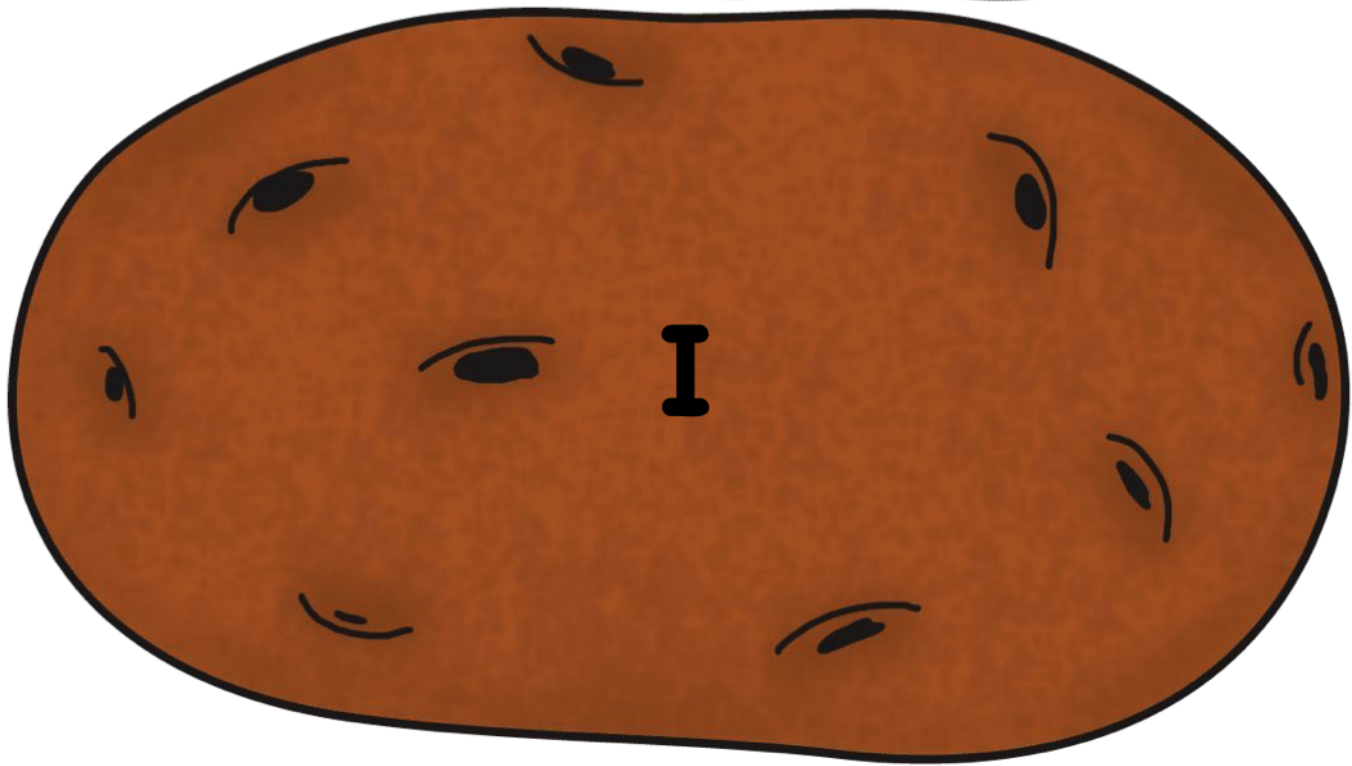
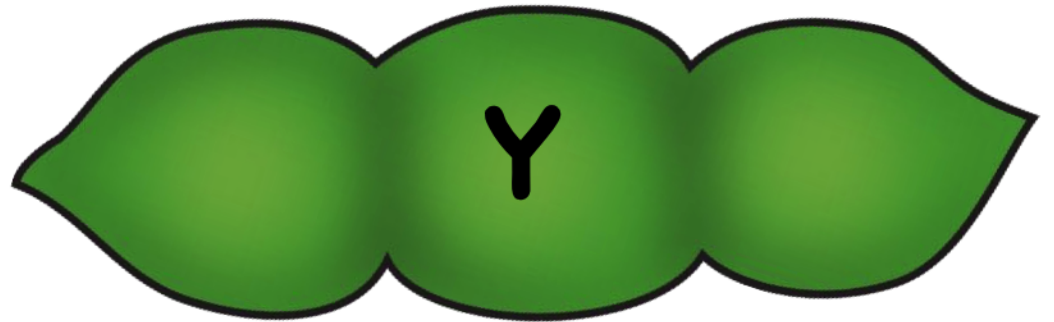
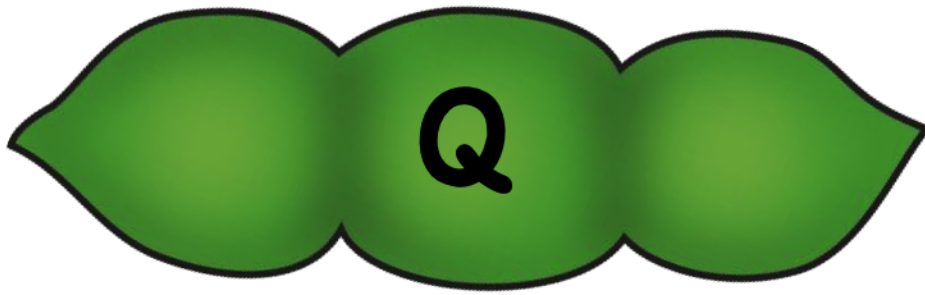
