

Play BINGO to practice recognizing money. BINGO cards include both front and back of coins as well as bills.

Select a player to be the BINGO caller. He/she will draw cards to read and/or show to players. The caller may select what round they would like to play. Options may be: straight line, "T", "X", 4 Corners or Full Board.

When a player has successfully won a round of BINGO by correctly recognizing money amounts, he or she becomes the new BINGO caller.
