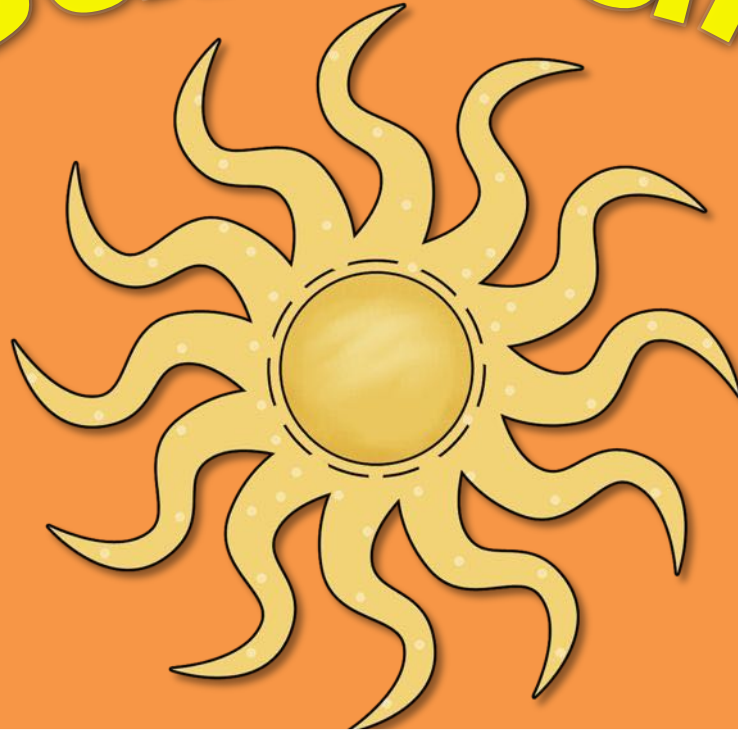


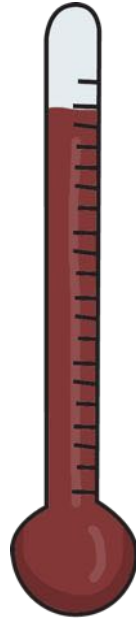
# Sun Fun!



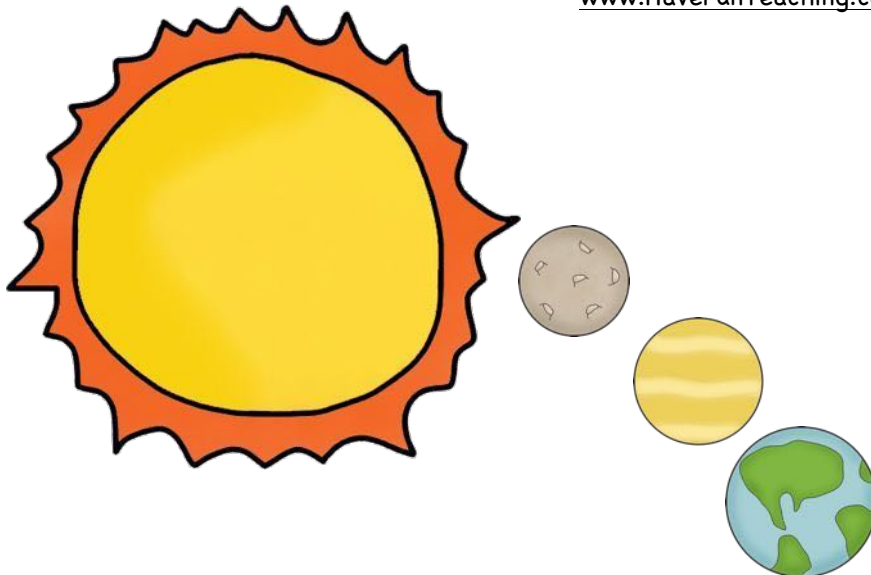

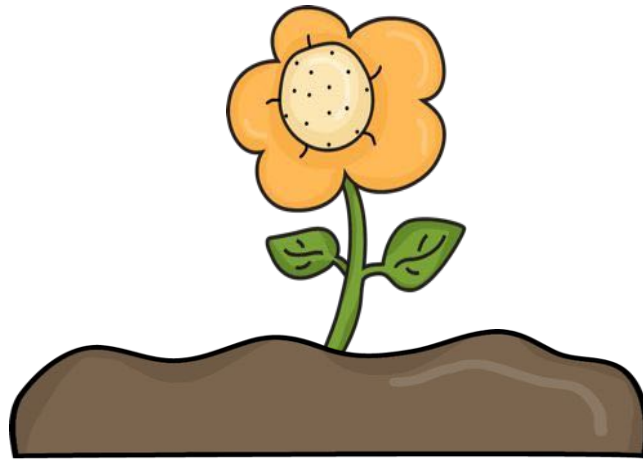
After completing this on-the-move Sun report, share it with a partner or your class.



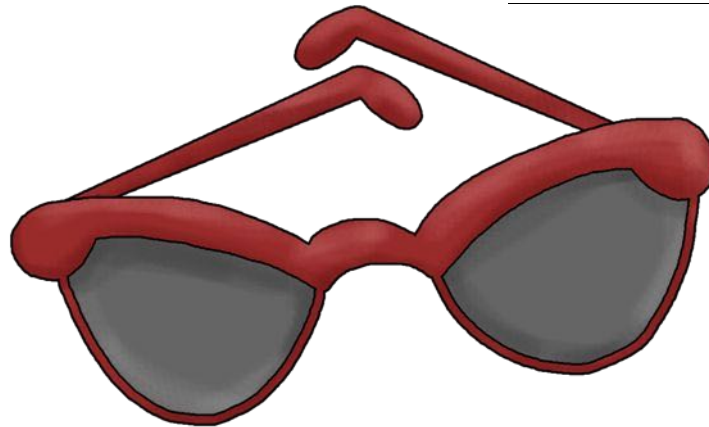
The sun is very hot!  
It is about 9,941<sup>o</sup> F.



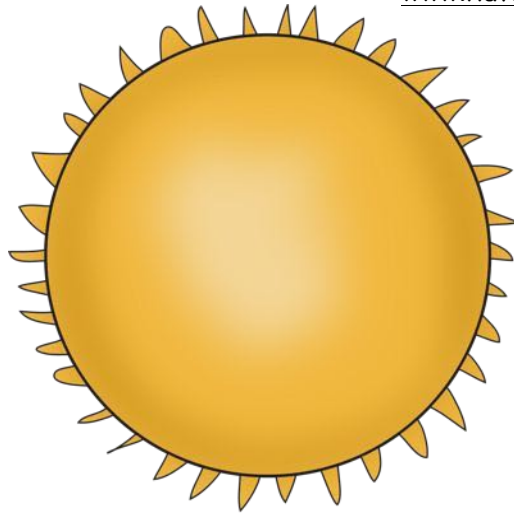
The sun is the center of the

grow.



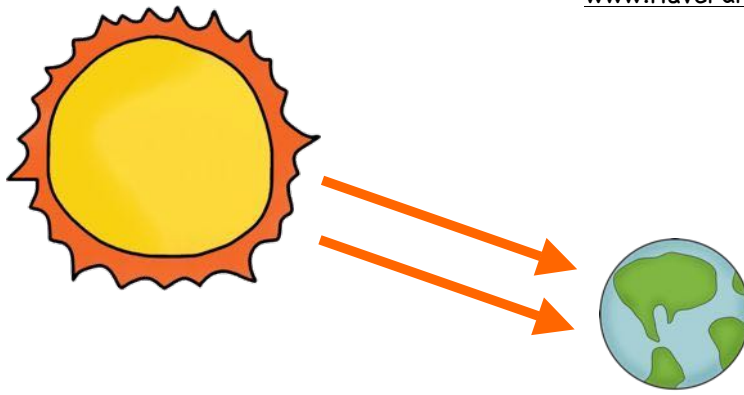
The sun can hurt your eyes!
