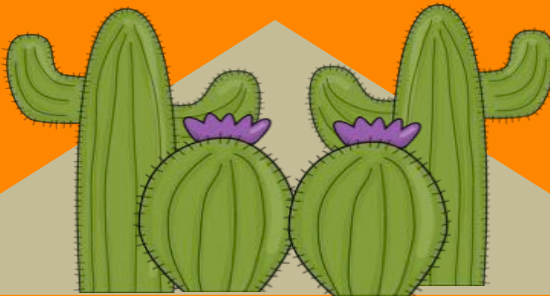


Play *Survivor* to test your desert knowledge and outplay your classmates!

Players put their game piece on the green oval. Roll the die and move that many spaces. Select a desert question card and read aloud. Think about your answer and tell the show host (your teacher).

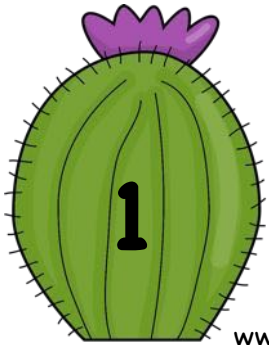

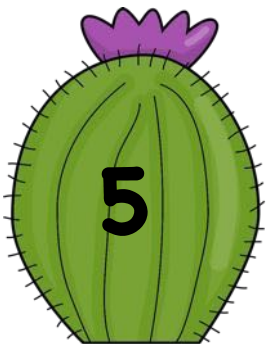
What is the largest desert?



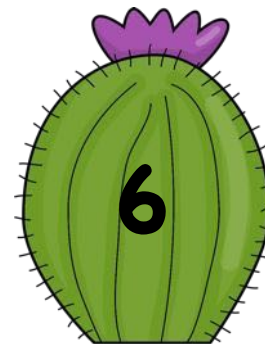

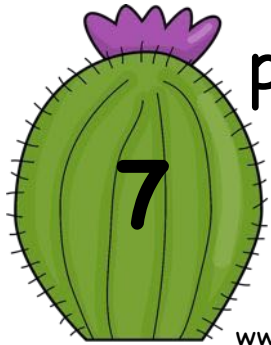

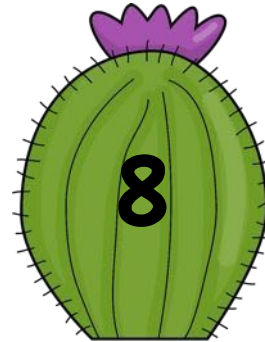

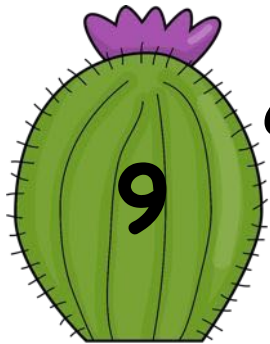

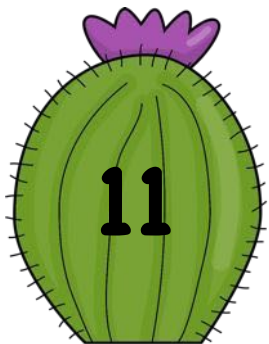

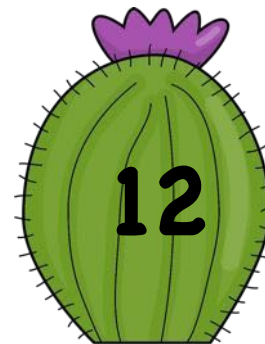

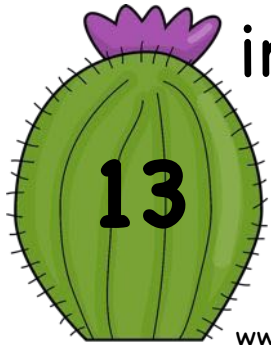

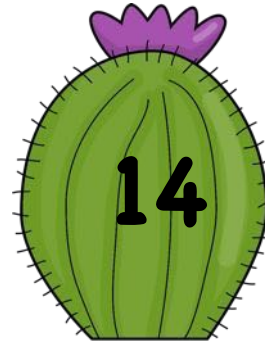

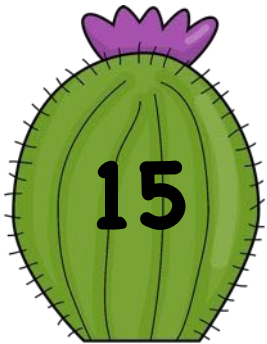
