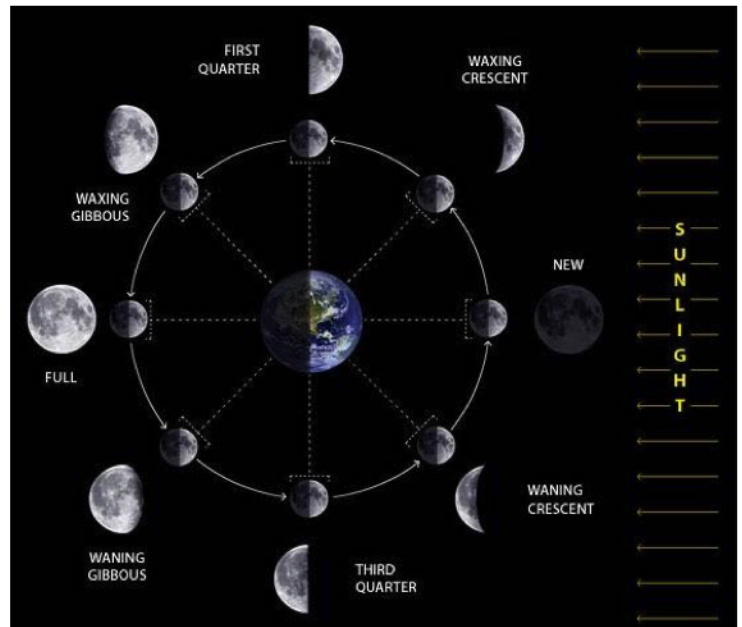

Phases of the Moon

The Earth's moon is a sphere that revolves around our Earth. At times, our Sun's rays shine onto the moon causing it to appear bright. Other times, our Earth blocks the Sun's rays and causes a shadow on the moon, making it seem smaller, taking on a different shape.
